Vendor Terms & Agreement

October 2–3, 2026 · North Stonington, Connecticut

This Vendor Agreement ("Agreement") governs participation by any vendor ("Vendor") accepted to operate at Bison Brook Rodeo (the "Event"). By submitting an application and accepting a vendor space, the Vendor agrees to be bound by the following terms.

1. Fees & Payment. The booth fee is \$500, payable upon acceptance to reserve the Vendor's space. All booth fees are non-refundable under any circumstances, including weather, cancellation, or failure to appear. The Event operates on a cash-free basis; Vendors shall be prepared to accept card or digital payment from customers.

2. Setup & Teardown. Setup may begin Thursday, October 1. Each booth must be fully operational before gates open (4:00 PM Friday and 2:00 PM Saturday). Vehicles and trailers shall remain in the designated service lot during Event hours and may not occupy the vendor area. Teardown shall occur only after the Event concludes, and each Vendor shall leave its space clean and free of debris.

3. Insurance & Permits. Each Vendor shall provide a valid Certificate of Insurance prior to setup. Food vendors shall additionally file a Temporary Food Event Permit with Ledge Light Health District and pass all required health and Fire Marshal inspections prior to opening; applications should be submitted early, as the fee increases within five business days of the Event and applications submitted the day prior will be denied. Each Vendor is solely responsible for obtaining all permits and licenses required for its operation and for compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

4. Operations. Site lighting is provided. Each Vendor is responsible for supplying any additional equipment or utilities necessary to conduct its operation.

5. Conduct. Vendors shall sell only those products or services identified in their application; any changes require prior approval. Vendors shall maintain a clean space, remove their own refuse to designated areas, and comply with all instructions issued by Event staff. The organizers reserve the right to remove any Vendor engaged in unsafe, unauthorized, or disruptive conduct, without refund.

6. Liability & Indemnification. Each Vendor operates at its own risk and is solely responsible for its equipment, products, personnel, and property. The Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold the organizers, their staff, contractors, sponsors, and the property owners harmless from any claim, loss, damage, or injury arising from or connected to the Vendor's participation in the Event.

7. Acceptance. By submitting an application, the Vendor acknowledges that it has read, understood, and agreed to these terms in full.
