Ticket Holder Agreement, Waiver & Release of Liability

October 2–3, 2026 · North Stonington, Connecticut

READ CAREFULLY — THIS AGREEMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING A WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK. It must be accepted at the time of ticket purchase, and every attendee is bound by it as a condition of entry. By completing your ticket purchase, you are electronically signing this Agreement on behalf of yourself and everyone in your party.

WARNING — AGRITOURISM ACTIVITY

You are entering a working farm and agritourism facility. Participation in any activity on this property involves inherent risks, including but not limited to:

- Uneven terrain, mud, rocks, holes, and other natural obstacles;
- Livestock and domestic animals that may behave unpredictably;
- Agricultural equipment, fencing, gates, vehicles, and machinery;
- Exposure to dust, insects, weather conditions, and other natural hazards.

By entering this property and participating in any activity, you acknowledge that you understand these inherent risks and voluntarily assume all risks of injury, illness, death, or property damage arising from your participation, **except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Releasees.**

Definitions. "Event" means Bison Brook Rodeo, held October 2–3, 2026 in North Stonington, Connecticut. "Releasees" means the Event and its organizers, owners, producers, promoters, Overpass Arena, sponsors, vendors, contractors, staff, volunteers, and agents, and the owners and lessors of the property on which the Event is held. "Ticket Holder" means each purchaser and holder of a ticket and each person admitted on that ticket.

By purchasing a ticket to, receiving a ticket for, or entering the Event, the Ticket Holder agrees, on behalf of themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and any minor in their care, to the following:

1. Voluntary Participation & Assumption of Risk. The Ticket Holder understands that the Event involves bull riding, livestock, large animals, mechanical equipment, and other rodeo and entertainment activities that are inherently and unavoidably dangerous, and that animals are unpredictable and may kick, charge, escape, or otherwise cause harm. The Event takes place on a working farm and agritourism facility, and the inherent risks include those described in the Agritourism Activity warning above — including uneven terrain, mud, holes, and other natural obstacles; the unpredictable behavior of livestock and domestic animals; agricultural equipment, fencing, gates, vehicles, and machinery; and exposure to dust, insects, weather, and other natural hazards. Risks include, without limitation, serious bodily injury, permanent disability, paralysis, communicable illness, and death, as well as loss of or damage to property. The Ticket Holder knowingly and voluntarily assumes all such risks, whether known or unknown, and whether or not arising from the ordinary negligence of the Releasees.

2. Waiver & Release of Liability. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Ticket Holder waives, releases, and discharges the Releasees from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, losses, costs, and expenses (including attorneys' fees) of any kind arising out of or related to attendance at or participation in the Event, including any claim based on the ordinary negligence of the Releasees.

3. Covenant Not to Sue. The Ticket Holder agrees not to sue or bring any claim against the Releasees for any matter released under this Agreement.

4. Indemnification & Hold Harmless. The Ticket Holder agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold the Releasees harmless from any claim, loss, liability, or expense (including attorneys' fees) brought by the Ticket Holder, any minor or guest in their care, or any third party, arising out of or related to the Ticket Holder's or their guests' presence at or conduct during the Event.

5. Minors. A Ticket Holder who brings or is responsible for any person under the age of eighteen (18) accepts this Agreement on that minor's behalf, assumes all risks on the minor's behalf, and agrees to the waiver, release, and indemnification above with respect to that minor to the fullest extent permitted by law.

6. Physical Condition & Medical Treatment. The Ticket Holder represents that they are physically able to attend safely and are not impaired. The Ticket Holder consents to receive emergency medical treatment if needed and agrees to be solely responsible for the cost of any such treatment.

7. Rules, Conduct & Ejection. The Ticket Holder shall remain behind all barriers, obey all posted rules and the instructions of Event staff, and conduct themselves lawfully. The Releasees may refuse entry to or eject any person for unsafe, disorderly, intoxicated, or unlawful conduct, without refund.

8. Personal Property & Parking. The Ticket Holder is responsible for their own personal property. Parking and entry onto the grounds are at the Ticket Holder's own risk, and the Releasees are not responsible for loss of or damage to vehicles or property.

9. No Refunds; Rain or Shine; Changes. All ticket sales are final and non-refundable for any reason. The Event proceeds rain or shine. The lineup, schedule, performers, and activities are subject to change or cancellation without notice, and such changes do not entitle the Ticket Holder to a refund.

10. Media Release. The Ticket Holder consents to being photographed, filmed, or recorded and grants the Releasees the perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free right to use their image, likeness, and voice for any promotional or commercial purpose without compensation or further approval.

11. Alcohol. Alcohol is served only to guests twenty-one (21) years of age or older with valid identification. The Ticket Holder agrees to consume responsibly and assumes all risks related to their consumption of alcohol.

12. Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is held unenforceable, that provision shall be enforced to the maximum extent permitted, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

13. Governing Law & Venue. This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Connecticut, and any dispute shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in New London County, Connecticut.

14. Electronic Acceptance & Signature. The Ticket Holder agrees that purchasing a ticket to the Event constitutes their electronic signature to this Agreement and their binding acceptance of all its terms, with the same force and effect as a handwritten signature. No separate signature is required for this Agreement to be enforceable against the Ticket Holder and any minor or guest in their care.

15. Entire Agreement & Acknowledgment. This Agreement is the entire agreement between the parties regarding its subject matter and supersedes any prior understanding. The Ticket Holder acknowledges that they have read this Agreement, had the opportunity to ask questions, understand it, and agree to it voluntarily.
